

CAMP SHOHOLA FOR BOYS

GROUP USE GUIDELINES

Under most circumstances, groups renting the camp facilities will only have use of cabins for lodging, the dining hall for dining and meetings, and the fields and courts for play.

Use of the waterfront for fishing or swimming and boating may be secured with special permission from the director. Unless special permission has been obtained from the director, the waterfront area is not to be used.

If the waterfront is used for swimming or boating, certified lifeguards must be provided by the group and life preservers will be worn at all times by boaters. Appropriate ratios for supervision must be maintained at all times.

If the waterfront is used for fishing, licenses must be obtained from the PA fish commission. The group is responsible for any fines incurred for not obtaining such licenses.

First aid and health care must be provided by the group for all of its participants along with general supervision at all times, and transportation in case of a medical emergency. The person providing such care must provide the camp with proof of certification in cpr if the group is adults only and first aid if it is a mixed group with youth. The certification must come from a nationally recognized provider. Camp Shohola will not have health care providers on staff during the use of the facilities. Information about nearest medical facilities and phone numbers will be provided by the camp. Health history forms must be obtained from each participant.

Follow Kitchen procedures as provided by the camp.

All groups are responsible to clean up the kitchen if they provide their own food service, the cabins they use, the dining hall, and the common areas used before their departure. Failure to do so may result in the forfeiture of some or all of the deposit.

Outdoor fires must be limited to designated areas only. The director must be notified in advance of creating an outdoor fire.

Alcohol consumption must be limited to adults of legal drinking age. Smoking must be restricted in any and all buildings. Designated smoking areas should have proper cigarette disposal. Please do not litter the ground with cigarette butts.

Use of illegal drugs by any participant during a group stay will result in the immediate dismissal of the entire group.
