## COSTS

For the purposes of this document, the use of the word “parent” or “parents” will denote parents or legal guardians.

**Deposit** – A deposit of \$1000 must be submitted with each application. This amount is credited to the camp fee. The balance of the camp fee is due in full by May 1, 2019. One half of the deposit is refundable through May 1, 2019. After we receive the application and deposit, we will send you the “parent welcome pack” by email. If you do not receive it, please check your email spam folder.

**Camp fee** – Season \$8750.00    Two Weeks \$3500.00    Three Weeks \$4750.00  
Four Weeks \$5900.00    Five Weeks \$7100.00

The full camp fee is due by May 1, 2019. No reduction can be made for late arrival or early departure. The fee includes infirmary care, weekly laundry service, some overnight camping, kayaking, rock climbing, mountain biking and canoe trips, and all materials used in instructional programs with the exception of electronics and rocketry kits. If a camper leaves early due to illness or accident, one half of the remaining fee will be refunded. Medical expenses resulting from doctor or hospital visits are the responsibility of parents.

**Spending allowance** – A spending allowance, in addition to the camp fee, will be charged on the invoice sent to parents. An account is established for each camper to cover store, optional trips such as the professionally-contracted whitewater rafting trips, summer theatre tickets and other admissions. If your son chooses golf, his clinic and greens fees will be charged against this account. Spending money and personal items such as stamps and grooming supplies are also charged against the spending allowance. Any unused amount will be returned to parents at the end of the session, unless parents indicate that they wish to donate it to the Shohola Scholarship Fund. Parents will be billed for any overdraw.

**Discount** – A discount of 5% will be made for two or more campers from the same family enrolled for four or more weeks at Camp Shohola and/or Camp Netimus.

**Tutoring** – Academic tutoring is available by special arrangement with the director. Cost is \$30 per hour.

**Transportation** – Optional transportation to and from camp by chartered bus from New York City, Philadelphia, Baltimore and Washington, DC is at additional cost. Specific information will be sent on enrollment.

**Visiting** – Parents may visit from July 20 to July 21. We encourage you to take your son out of camp for that night as there are no regularly scheduled activities at that time. Visits to one month campers must be limited to the first or last day of the session in which the camper is enrolled.

Children will be signed out of camp to the custody of the parents only. Exceptions to this policy will be made only with written notice given prior to visiting day. Any legal issues that we should know about regarding custody must be brought to our attention in writing along with legal documentation. Otherwise it will be assumed that any parent has custody rights.

## NOTE TO INTERNATIONAL PARENTS

**Linen and trunk rental** – International campers may rent blankets, sheets, a pillow, towels, and a trunk in which to store clothing. The cost is \$70 for five week or season campers and \$50.00 for two, three or four week campers.

**New York area airport transportation** – We offer optional airport pickup service for the following cost: Newark - \$200.00 Round Trip    JFK - \$350.00 Round Trip. We strongly recommend that you book your son’s flight to Newark, NJ as this can often reduce the travel time back to camp by several hours simply due to traffic.

\*\*\*No return flights prior to 12:00 noon will be accepted.\*\*\*

**Method of payment** – All fees must be paid in U.S. dollars. If possible, please make payment by a check written from a U.S. bank account in U.S. dollars. If that is not possible, payment may be made by one of the alternative methods outlined in the “2019 Information for Parents and Campers” which will be forwarded to you by email after enrollment.
